We have been part of a true work of the Holy Spirit! Since Sunday we recorded 71 first time decisions for Christ, on Monday we recorded 828 first time decisions for Christ, along with 4 decisions in route to Peru, giving us a total to date of 903!

Now we must become even more focused on the road ahead of us. We have seen some tremendous initial success. Our continued success is dependent upon holiness, and reliance upon God and prayer. Remember, He must increase and we must decrease.

Ministry Team Reports

Film Teams:

One of our teams showed a film about a family tonight. Nyke Gatlin led a team to minister in a park with this film. He reported to us that a young man was present who was addicted to marijuana, and was also a drug dealer. Nyke shared Christ with this man and two of his companions, and all three of them accepted Christ!

Music Ministry Teams:

Dale Nelson led another person to the Lord again today at the Ovalo Park. Meanwhile, the adult choir was really rocking at the Temple tonight, and many were blessed by their music ministry.

Medical Team:

Today the Medical Team implanted a pacemaker into a 7 year old boy along with Peruvian doctors at the children's hospital. Prior to the surgery the boy was passing out. To date, the Medical Team has surgically implanted 17 pacemakers, some of which are life saving surgeries. The team is experiencing many opportunities to share the lord with doctors and medical students. Four more implants are scheduled for this week. One doctor in training is going through the death of her mother, so let's pray for her. Dr. Dan Neubauer prayed with a number of people today.



Flom & Kelm Family:

The Kelms saw an incredible demonstration of the Holy Spirit, with 20 first time decisions from a group of 35 people who gathered at their event. Even though the team experienced technical difficulties with the sound system, it served only to cause more people to gather for the presentation.



Student & Children Outreach:

A number of our students and adults saw the Lord work in a mighty way today. Anna Garin lead her first person to Christ; a young boy about 8 years old. Wade oversaw 4-5 boys come to Christ. Dee Dee and Kris led a little girl to Christ.



Rick Brama prayed with 3 young men to receive Christ using the EvangeCube. Lisa Olsen, while going door to door, spoke with an elderly woman who stated that you could not be sure that you were going to go to Heaven. Lisa gave her testimony and shared the Gospel and the woman prayed to receive Christ. Curtis Vaughn also had a first time experience in leading people to Christ; He got down on his knees and prayed with 8 children today! Molly Peterson prayed with a number of people at the Callao church. Aren't we thankful for our kids for catching the vision!! Jed Culbertson reports that in one park he ministered in with the Students, 85 people alone came to Christ. He said that many of the students were jumping off the walls with excitement over the events of the day. Nyke reports, that one student who witnessed many ministry problems learned the importance of prayer. So they engaged in frequent prayer throughout the day and they saw God intervene and produce fruit despite some bad circumstances. During a hospital visit, a woman who was in very bad health prayed a prayer of Salvation, as her husband watched on tearfully. Christina Nordstrom and Blue Olson prayed with a women and her adult son in a parking lot to receive Christ. Caryl Hayward prayed with 10 people today to receive Christ. There were about 150 first time decisions through the Hospital visitation today.

Miscellaneous Items of Importance

- **Preventative Care:** Dr. Manoles has reminded us tonight of the importance of washing hands, and observing all that has been communicated to us regarding what should be avoided in our diets. Some of our people are experiencing diarrhea, and general lower tract discomfort. If you are careful, there is a better chance you can avoid this.
