

Titus 2 Women's Discipleship Ministry

Titus 2: 3-5 Older women likewise are to be reverent in behavior, not slanderers or slaves to much wine. They are to teach what is good, and so train the younger women to love their husbands and children, to be self-controlled, pure, working at home, kind and submissive to their own husbands, that the world may not be reviled.

The leadership team of this ministry intentionally wants to equip women to understand and live out biblical principles of womanhood in all seasons of life through mentor/mentee relationships. This ministry provides the opportunity for relationships among the women of Grace and is committed to equipping women to pass on the gospel, to help others treasure Jesus Christ, and to become established in their faith.

These are offered in various formats, they include:

- Small Group Discipleship
- 1 on 1 Discipleship
- Book Study on Biblical Womanhood
- Homemaking Discipleship

The groups will meet whenever it is convenient for each particular group. A new option for Fall 2008 is Tuesday morning discipleship groups, which will be conducted at the same time as the Tuesday morning Bible Studies. This begins Tuesday September 23rd, 9:30 - 11:30 am. A Children's Program and Childcare are available.

New Groups are formed in the Fall and will run through May of the following year. It is a 9-month commitment, that can be extended if participants agree to do so.

This ministry is always seeking women who are equipped to be a discipleship leader. Requirements to be a leader **DO NOT** include:

- A PhD in Bible or recognition as a Bible scholar
- Total satisfaction with one's own Christian walk
- A counselor's degree
- Assurance that one has all the answers
- Willingness to be a babysitter

but rather, requirements **DO** include:

- Commitment to the Word of God and prayer
- Trustworthiness
- Humility
- Availability
- Membership in Grace Church
- Agreement with the Grace Church mission and statement of faith.
- Full support of the work of the church and of the elders.
- If married, husband's support of participation in this ministry
- Faithfulness in following through in commitment to this ministry.

There are Discipleship leader training sessions (approximately every 4-6 weeks) throughout the 9 months for those who would like them.

Women of all ages and seasons of life who want to be discipled and call Grace their home church are welcome to participate.
